Many marginalized and underserved communities lack crucial access to clean and safe water and are the most vulnerable to contaminant exposure and have a harder time to overcome capacity challenges.

This webinar will focus on how States could use their DWSRF set-asides for activities that identify and prioritize water infrastructure and capacity building projects for underserved communities. You'll also hear from State presenters on their efforts to build capacity and advance water equity.
